Those interested in presenting a paper are invited to submit an electronic copy of the final paper (Word or PDF) or an at least two pages long outline attached to an e-mail message to alacde@alacde.org. Papers can be submitted either in English, Spanish or Portuguese.

Proposals should also include an abstract in English; keywords; JEL classification; and contact information, including author's complete name, e-mail, telephone, postal address and current academic or professional position.

The submission deadline is April 10th, 2013.
